## Document Summary

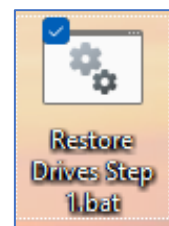
This should take 2-5 minutes depending on your connection to the internet.

## Document Detail

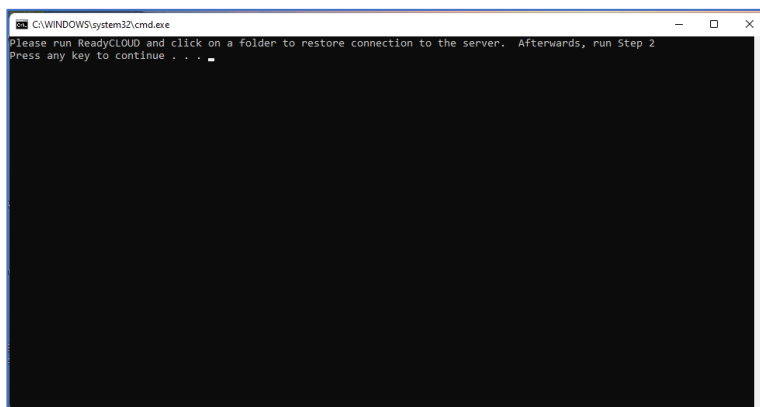
To restore the connection to your ReadyCLOUD mapped drives do the following.

1. Run **'Restore Drives step 1.bat'**

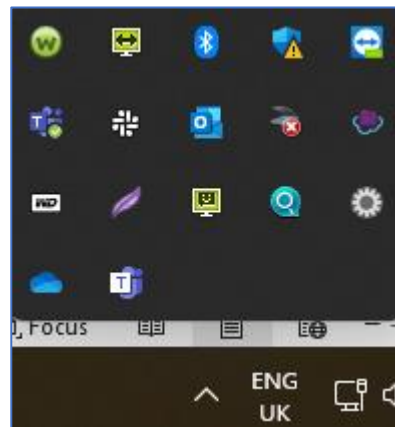
This will disconnect your current drives.



When it is finished the following screen will show.



2. Next you need to go to your ReadyCLOUD in your hidden icons  
On your task bar – next to the clock, click the left mouse button.



3. Then hit the refresh button



4. After ReadyCLOUD reloads, click on a folder and it should open up in file explorer. You can then run 'Restore Drives step 2.bat'



Your drives should now be working in your File Explorer.
